#### Frequently Asked Questions & Answers

- **How long is the production?** It is 75 minutes, with no intermission.
- **Do I need a ticket to attend?** No; a free-will offering will be accepted at the performance.
- **Is seating reserved? Can I reserve seats for a group?** *It is not possible to reserve seating for this event.*
- **How many people are in the play?** It is a one-man play, performed by actor Andrae Goodnight of Saint Luke Productions. The production includes a multimedia component, featuring a video backdrop that portrays a full cast of characters.
- **Is the play suitable for all ages?** Due to some mature themes, we recommend the *Tolton* performance for ages 10 and up.
- **Is there a nursery available? Where is it located?** *No.*
- **Will Saint Luke Productions have DVDs, books, etc., available for sale?** Yes! There will also be materials available from the Springfield Diocesan Black Catholic Committee.
- **Will Andrae Goodnight be available to greet the audience for autographs after the performance?** Yes!
- **Is there a reception after the performance?** *Guests will be able to meet actor Andrae Goodnight after the performance but there is no formal reception.*
- **Who wrote the play?** Saint Luke Productions' founder, Leonardo Defilippis, wrote and directed the play, under the guidance of Bishop Joseph Perry of Chicago, the postulator for Fr. Tolton's canonization cause. The writing process involved extensive research in to Fr. Tolton's life and times.
