<u>What is Spiritual Direction</u>?

In the journey of faith, we are called to be open and respond to the guidance of God's Spirit. Spiritual direction is a process, and the journey takes place in the context of confidential, oneon-one conversations. Spiritual direction is not therapy or counseling, but a time to reflect on and affirm your gifts and God's love and movement in your life.

Why do Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction offers support in understanding how God is working in your life. It helps you to integrate the many facets of your life journey, inviting wholeness and deeper self-knowledge.

What about Frequency?

Frequency of sessions will vary with the life needs of each directee. Most come once a month for about an hour.

If you experience:

- a yearning to grow in your relationship with God...
- a desire to understand that relationship in a new way...
- a need to discern the best choices for your life...
- a sense of a call from God to some form of prayer or service...
- a crisis of faith in which previous answers no longer suffice...
- a hunger and thirst that never seems to be satisfied...

...then Spiritual Direction may be a helpful process for you.
